Essential Qualifications: The candidates who have done their Ph.D. in Geology/Applied Geology/Earth Sciences and related areas from the Indian Universities/Institute with NIRF ranking of up to 20 (overall or in the respective area) or those who have done Ph.D. abroad will be eligible. The candidates must have a proven track record with published work of at least two papers in Q1 or Q2 journals or SCOPUS / Web of Science listed journals.

Upper age limit: The upper age is 45 years (5 years relaxation for female/SC/ST/Physically Handicapped Candidate) and other selection criteria for this fellowship (RJP-PDF) are as per the rule of the Government of India and Banaras Hindu University. Age relaxation will be given for SC/ST/Physically Handicapped candidates as per rules.

Desirable Qualifications: The candidate should have a basic knowledge of Geology and a strong motivation in the field of hydrogeology/Isotope hydrology/watershed management.
